Silver Willow Golf and Sporting Club has 14 unique stations with a shooting stand and 25 fully automated machines. Once the participant is in the stand and ready to shoot, a bright orange clay disk is released from the machine. The objective is to shoot and hit the clay targets as they fly past the station. The trajectory of the disk varies from station to station giving the participant a great deal of variety throughout the course. On one station, the clay disk rolls and bounces along the ground, while on another station, two disks fly by in different directions.

This is a new and emerging sport, for men and women! For those who are new to the sport*, there will be an instructor to walk you through the steps involved in shooting, take you out to the course and help you at each station.
